



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS OF MEMBERS TO SERVE ON NATIONAL LANGUAGE BODIES (NLBs)

The Pan South African Language Board (PanSALB) hereby invites members of the public and institutions with an interest in languages to nominate persons to be considered for appointment to PanSALB's National Language Bodies (NLBs) for the eleven official languages (Sepedi/Sesotho sa Leboa, Sesotho, Setswana, Siswati, Tshivenda, Xitsonga, Afrikaans, English, isiNdebele, isiXhosa, isiZulu), Khoi, Nama and San languages, and Sign Language (SASL).

Each National Language Body (NLB) operates in terms of Section 8 (8)(b) of the Pan South African Language Board Act (Act 59 of 1995), as amended, and PanSALB's Norms and Rules for National Language Bodies (Board Notice 94 of 2005).

Members serve on a part-time basis for a period of five years from the date of appointment. There is no remuneration as this is regarded as community work. PanSALB covers costs related to travel and accommodation for members appointed to serve on the respective NLBs.

Suitable persons must satisfy the following requirements:

- Be first language speakers or users of the language concerned;
- Have passion and commitment for, and contribute to, the development and use of the language concerned;
- Have specialist and extensive knowledge of the language concerned as well as expertise in any of these areas: Language Standardisation, Terminology Development, Lexicography, Literature and Media, Translation and Interpreting, as well as Language in Education.

Nominations should be submitted in writing and must include the following details:

- The title, full names, addresses (physical and postal) and contact details of the nominee, nominator and seconder, and a two-page Curriculum Vitae (CV) of the nominee. The CV must include the nominee's full names, ID number and gender, contact address, name of province, contact numbers, fax number and e-mail address (if any), and descriptions of experience, knowledge and skills.
- Certified copies of the ID, academic and professional qualifications of the nominee.
- Any other supporting information, including names and contact details of at least two (2) referees.
- Duly completed and signed forms for the nominator, the seconder and the nominee.

No nomination will be considered unless all of the above are included.
