PAN SOUTH AFRICAN LANGUAGE BOARD

ADVERT CALLING FOR THE NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES TO SERVE ON THE SIX PROVINCIAL LANGUAGE COMMITTEES (PLCs) OF PANSALB, NAMELY; THE EASTERN CAPE PLC, FREE STATE PLC, KWAZULU-NATAL PLC, MPUMALANGA PLC, NORTHERN CAPE PLC, THE NORTH WEST PLC, GAUTENG PLC AND LIMPOPO PLC IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PAN SOUTH AFRICAN LANGUAGE BOARD ACT NO. 59 OF 1995, SECTION 8(8)(a).

The Pan South African Language Board (PanSALB) hereby calls for nominations of candidates to serve on these PLCs in accordance with Section 8(8)(a) of the PanSALB Act, No. 59 of 1995, after due consultation with the Members of the Executive Councils (MEC) of the Provinces respectively and responsible for matters related to languages.

Each PLC shall consist of not more than thirteen (13) persons with the following criterion:

1. Must be first language speakers or users of the languages they represent in a particular province, SA citizens and reside in a Provinces of that specific PLC,
2. Have extensive knowledge of all official SA languages of a PLC's province and shall include
 - 2.1 the Khoi and San Languages
 - 2.2 South African Sign Language and
 - 2.3 Heritage Languages
3. Potential nominees should have passion for and contribute to language development by advising in the following fields:
 - 3.1 Translation and interpreting of language matters of their Provinces including the establishment, compilation and maintenance of databases thereof
 - 3.2 Status Language Planning and Language Legislation formulation
 - 3.3 Lexicography and Terminology Development ,
 - 3.4 Conducting Research in language matters and
 - 3.5 Monitoring the Human Linguistic Rights matters in their provinces (legal knowledge will be an advantage)
4. Required documents from potential nominees are as follows:
 - 4.1 A certified copy of the SA Identity Document (ID);
 - 4.2 Certified copies of authentic relevant qualifications in the fields of languages and research &
 - 4.3 An abridged curriculum vitae.
